

basketball hoops for our outside learning area and the children have thoroughly enjoyed trying to throw the


ball through the hoops. In the kitchen this week we have been making our very own fruit kebabs; the children cut their own fruit and thread it


onto their wooden stick before enjoying it at the snack table. This week we had our first Woodland Adventures session with Mrs Self. We used our

Wednesday 25th September 7pm - EYFS Parents' Curriculum Evening (Hall).




