Nursery and Pre Reception News



What a wonderful week we have had in Nursery. The children have settled fabulously into the new routines of Nursery and have been busy making new friends. Our topic this term in 'I wonder how it feels'; we have been thinking carefully about how it feels to start school and how we can share these feelings with our friends and teachers. Our focus story this week has been 'The Colour Monster'; we have shared the story dur-



ing group time and talked about when we might feel a range of emotions such as happy, sad and angry. All of the monsters in the story have a special colour, do you know what they are? The Nursery children are experts, if you ask them, they will be able to tell you about which colour monsters match the different emotions. We have been thinking about colours this



week and using our fine motor skills to collect different resources and sort them by colour. In the kitchen we have been developing our knife skills; the children began by using a bridge cut to slice their own fruit, we then developed our skill to spread butter on bread to make sandwiches. This week we have been learning about the changes that happen when we put bread in a toaster; the children then used their knife skills to spread the topping on the toast. What a busy week.
