St Christopher's Uniform



We are very proud of our smart school uniform that not only gives pupils a strong sense of identity but also connects them to our rich heritage dating back to 1938.

Maintaining high standards in our uniform is essential, and ensuring that children wear the correct attire without exceptions is key to this goal.

This booklet offers clear guidance on the uniform standards for both the School and Nursery. We value parental support in making sure that children come to school dressed correctly and smartly.

All items listed in this uniform guide are compulsory, unless stated otherwise.

If a uniform item is not in School, our office staff will contact parents, expecting the item to be brought in on the same morning. Your cooperation is invaluable in helping us uphold our uniform expectations.



Nursery & Pre-Reception Uniform

Please also provide the following items for your child:

Spare uniform clothes (named) in a spare bag, to be kept in Nursery Bag



Nursery Bag* (navy cotton with school logo and child's named embroidered in gold)

House T-Shirt* (required for house events such as Sports Day)

All clothing must be clearly labelled.

Please sew large ribbon loops in your child's jacket and sweatshirt to assist them in hanging up their clothes.

Uniform

White polo shirt with school logo in child's house colour

Sweatshirt—navy with school logo

Joggers – navy (without pockets)

Shorts – navy

Socks—navy blue short socks, please no tights.

Jacket—navy blue fleece lined with school logo

Sun hat with school logo

Woollen hat with school logo

Plain blue or black mittens (not gloves) on a string

Footwear

Plain blue or black polishable leather shoes, preferably with a Velcro fastening.

No slip on shoes or open toe sandals should be worn.

Hair and Jewellery

Hairstyles should be neat and tidy. Hair should be cut, tied or clipped back so that none falls over the eyes. Hair fastenings should be plain navy blue.

No jewellery should be worn except if ears have been pierced, only the simplest of plain gold or silver studs (round) may be worn. Watches should not be worn.

Reception, Year 1 & 2 Uniform - Girls



All clothing must be clearly labelled.

Please sew a large ribbon loop in the blazer, fleece and sweatshirt to assist children in hanging up their clothes.

Summer Uniform

(Summer and first half of Autumn term only)

St Christopher's summer dress - tartan

Socks - plain white, ankle or $\frac{3}{4}$ length

Straw boater - with band

Sun hat with school logo

Winter Uniform

(After October half-term until end of Spring term)

Blouse - blue, long sleeve, reverse collar

Grey tunic with school logo

Winter hat with band

Tights - plain grey

Woollen hat - with school logo

School scarf - optional*

Gloves - navy - optional

Navy winter coat no logos—optional must be worn over the blazer

Required all Year

Blazer - grey with embroidered badge

Cardigan - petrol blue with school logo

Fleece - navy with school logo

Rainproof coat - navy with school logo

Waterproof navy trousers for Outdoor Adventures
(Reception only)

Footwear

Plain black polishable leather shoes - sensible buckle or Velcro. No slip on shoes or open toe sandals should be worn.

Hair and Jewellery

Hairstyles should be neat and tidy. Hair should be cut, tied or clipped back so that none falls over the eyes.

Hair fastenings should be plain navy blue.

Reception, Year 1 & 2 Uniform - Boys



All clothing must be clearly labelled.

Please sew a large ribbon loop in the blazer, fleece and sweatshirt to assist children in hanging up their clothes.

Summer Uniform

(Summer and first half of Autumn term only)

Short sleeved shirt—blue (no tie)
Shorts—charcoal grey knee length
Socks - plain grey cotton ankle length
Sun hat with school logo

Winter Uniform

(After October half-term until end of Spring term)

Shirt - blue, long sleeve with top button
Tie—blue with grey and gold stripe
Shorts—charcoal grey knee length
Socks - grey 3/4 length with school coloured bands
Woollen hat - with school logo
School scarf - optional*
Gloves - navy - optional
Navy winter coat no logos—optional must be worn over the blazer

Required all Year

Blazer - grey with embroidered badge
Cap - grey flannel with embroidered badge
Jumper - petrol blue with school logo
Fleece - navy with school logo
Rainproof coat - navy with school logo
Waterproof navy trousers for Outdoor Adventures
(Reception only)

Footwear

Plain black polishable leather shoes - sensible buckle or Velcro. No slip on shoes or open toe sandals should be worn.

Hair and Jewellery

Hairstyles should be neat and tidy. Hair should be cut, tied or clipped back so that none falls over the eyes. Hair fastenings should be plain navy blue. Reception, Year 1 & 2 - PE Kit

We kindly request that your child brings their PE kit to school on Monday morning, so that it is readily available throughout the week. PE kit will be sent home on a Friday.

White polo shirt with logo in child's House Colour

Navy PE shorts

Navy joggers (without pockets)

Navy sweatshirt with School logo

White ankle-length socks

Named PE bag*

Footwear

Plain black trainers, with a Velcro fastening

House T-Shirt *

* These items can be purchased through ParentMail or at the School Office.



Hot Weather Dress

Parents will be informed via Parent Mail, when Hot Weather Dress is in place. Pupils may take advantage of the following relaxations to the Uniform.

- Blazers optional
- Girls boaters optional
- Boys caps optional
- Nursery children to wear shorts

Pupils revert to the standard Uniform on Year 2 Leavers Day and on return to School in September.

Items purchased via the School

The follow are ordered directly from the School

- Nursery Bag / PE Bag— a navy cotton bag with school logo and child's named embroidered in gold, ordering instructions will come in your parent pack.
- Coloured House T-Shirt—required for house events such as Sports Day, purchased via ParentMail.
- School Scarf - optional item purchased via ParentMail

PTA Second Hand Uniform Sales

The PTA (our parents association) run a second hand uniform sale every term. This is a good opportunity to buy essential uniform items at less than 50% of the retail price, whilst raising some funds for the PTA.

These sales are always well stocked with excellent quality items.

Naming Uniform

It is essential that all uniform items are clearly labelled.

Please sew large ribbon loops in blazers, jackets, caps, fleeces and sweatshirts to assist children in hanging up their clothes.

Lost Property

Clearly named items will be returned to the children via their peg. There is a large box situated under the porch back door, where anything without a discernible name will be put. At the end of the school year unclaimed property will be given to charity.
